### How Is DHS Planning for New FY20 Resources?

### **FY20 PSH Vouchers**

- Increasing provider case management capacity:
  - Expanding capacity with existing PSH providers to absorb new FY20 PSH CM slots starting October 1
  - Working with providers and OCP to increase HCAs and plan for CM assignments by quarter
- Increasing DHS staff capacity PSH/TAH:
  - New Contract Administration (1) and program staff for PSH and TAH portfolio (5)



# How Is DHS Planning for New FY20 Resources (cont.)?

### Outreach - \$3.6M

- Planning underway for new solicitation to establish coordinated Citywide outreach network.
- Anticipated release for RFA: mid-July

#### **Diversion (individuals)/Project Reconnect- \$875K**

- Planning in early stages. May include additional staff training.

### **Diversion (families)/HPP - \$798K**

- RFA is out/closes on July 12. DHS will be selecting up to 4 providers to continue strengthening prevention efforts.

#### Youth Division - \$5.38M

- Expanding provider capacity: New solicitations planned for TAY shelter, transitional housing, and extended transitional housing (PSH)
- Increasing DHS staff capacity: new contract administration and program management staff
