Meeting Notes

I. WELCOME AND CALL TO ORDER

ICH Executive Director, Theresa Silla, and ICH Graphic Designer, Daisean Foster, facilitated a design focused icebreaker as Committee members joined the meeting. Attendees were invited to share feedback on options for the ERSO Committee logo.

Co-chair, Reginald Black (PFFC, CEWG) welcomed the group and notified the group that the recording was started and provided an overview of the agenda and invited other attendees to introduce themselves through the chat. Director Silla covered housekeeping reminders for the Committee outlined on slides 7 and 8.

II. DISCUSSION

A. HYPOTHERMIA CHECK-IN

FEBRUARY ALERTS & OPERATIONAL SHIFTS

Shaquin Grier (DHS) covered this topic and shared data on the number of hypothermia alerts. Director Silla covered operational shifts and outcomes.

Comments, recommendations, feedback from the discussion are included below and were also recorded directly in the slides in red text. Please see PPT slides 9 – 16 for details.

Comments/Recommendations/Feedback:

- Activating Warming Buses: recommendation to consider % capacity of city-wide shelter beds as a threshold factor for utilization of warming buses. For example, activate once shelter beds are 80%-90% full during cold days or alerts.
- Day Center Hours & Transportation: Observation that surge in people at the 5 o'clock hour at the Downtown Day Services Center (DDSC) would be because of the need for shelter transport. Request for data on the number of people using transport from DDSC.

Next Step:

• ICH will tabulate all hypothermia and operational shift related feedback and recommendations for review in development of FY24 Winter Plan.

TRANSITION PLAN FOR OVERFLOW SITES & PEP-V

Shaquin Grier (DHS) was not able to stay on the call, so Director Silla (ICH) covered the slide for transition plan for overflow sites. Dena Hasan (DHS) presented updates on PEP-V. - OMS Contact Info: Request for contact information of OMS. UPO gets calls from migrants and families
 requesting information. DHS now has a central email <u>Migrant.services@dc.gov</u> Standard shelter hotline for
 afterhours is recommended families will be referred to VWFRC and individuals referred to low barrier
 shelters.
- Additional questions posed by meeting attendees in the WebEx chat are listed below, though ICH will work with DHS to confirm responses:
 - o Who is the contact person for accurate answers to questions?
 - Does OMS have live customer service to inquiries?
 - Since 2022, how many immigrants have been housed in DC? What is the average weekly or monthly flow of families and individuals?
 - To avoid misinformation, how does OMS provide community outreach?
