

Shelter Capacity Committee
Single Adults Winter Plan 2018-2019 Recommendations
Revised June 27, 2018

Overview

The Shelter Capacity Committee met on June 14, 2018 to review the usage rates for single homeless men and women for the winter of 2017-2018. Based upon the Committee's review, we noted that the highest reported usage for men was 1,393 and for women 501. The most frequently reported usage rate for men was 1,099 and for women 385.

Men

The Shelter Capacity Committee recommends the overall bed capacity for men for the winter of 2018-2019 should be 1,401. The Committee noted that the Greenleaf Recreation Center, which provided 50 beds for men briefly last winter, will be used for women only for the winter of 2018-2019.

Women

The Shelter Capacity Committee recommends the overall bed capacity for women for the winter of 2018-2019 should be 600 beds.

The following is the general proposed breakdown:

The Committee noted that the District government is expanding the capacity at Harriet Tubman for 175 - 200 beds for women. The additional 75 - 100 beds are expected to come on line this winter. The additional beds could increase the overall women's capacity to 675 - 700 beds by the end of the winter 2018-2019.
