• Unrelated to the Pipeline Review:

- Eviction Support Feedback from one providers that they are currently seeing patients who are told they are ineligible for services because they have not yet been evicted, however have a designated eviction date. Question on what services are available to these individuals to start the process of receiving services once they are evicted. Flag that this is a larger system question that is not relevant to the discussion topics to be covered in the Housing Solutions Committee.
- ERAP: Feedback from person with lived experience that ERAP does NOT work fast enough and there are
 often complications with reimbursements and program infrastructure to support with emergency
 moves.
- Vacancy Rates in the District: Question on the number of vacant units in the redevelopments in the District of Columbia. This will not be covered directly under this Committee. Hammere Gebreyes (DC Housing Authority) noted the questions and will coordinate with colleagues to provide relevant updates in the appropriate forum.

Next Steps:

- ICH to connect with Nechama Masliansky to determine if the provider group lead by SOME has appropriate materials/updates to include/feature during the next ICH Housing Solutions Committee meeting.
- ICH to support identifying the appropriate answers to questions that are not related to housing production or the scope of the Housing Solutions Committee, including eviction support and ERAP related feedback.
- ICH to work with DHCD to identify appropriate resources for community feedback/input in the development
 process and initiatives that address Vacant Units throughout the District. As appropriate, updates to be shared
 with the Housing Solutions Committee members and inform future meeting agendas.

B. PRELIMINARY FINDINGS FROM LISTENING SESSIONS

Director Silla introduced and facilitated this topic. Please see slides 13-17 for more information about the project. Notes from the Committee discussion on this presentation were also recorded directly in slide 17 highlighted in red text. Note that the following memo *HSG Slns_Memo_Preliminary Findings from Listening Sessions* is attached and was distributed to the Committee prior to the meeting.

Questions/Comments/Feedback:

- Alignment with Goal 12: Question on how this project and the Housing Solutions Committee is aligning and prioritizing Goal 12 in Homeward DC 2.0 The District providing leadership on creating a right to housing in the United States. This feedback was also raised as a priority in the ICH Racial Equity & Inclusion (REI) Workgroup.
- Housing Lease Up/Tax Credit Deadlines: Feedback from providers that the District/DHCD has been making it as easy as possible for developing dedicated units and responding to the Consolidated RFP. However, there are still several gaps with DHS and DCHA portions of the process to mend and help developers to meet tax credit deadlines.
- Pre-development Funds: DHCD highlighted the Oramenta Newsome Nonprofit Development Fund to support
 nonprofit developers. Shellon Fraser (NHT) noted concern on accessibility and ongoing availability of these

- Observation that the new allocation process addresses feedback received during the listening sessions
 requesting a regular cadence for funding and review. This allows for landlords and developers to adequately
 prepare for application and review processes.
