A. CONSTITUENT CONCERNS

Director Silla reviewed the updated tracker of constituent concerns from across ICH forums, highlighting concerns that are most relevant to the Housing Solutions Committee.

Comments, concerns, and questions from the discussion are captured on slide 14. Topic areas are summarized here for easy reference:

- Positive feedback on the new tracker reflecting constituent concerns.
- Reminder to explain acronyms and avoid jargon where possible and flag to provide orientation materials to support participation and informed decision making.
- Question on efforts to preserve existing public housing, especially given concerns of inadequate and poor conditions of current units with a flag about Green Initiative.
- Concerns about food access and feedback that not adequately addressed in Shelter Solutions WG.

A. STUDY ON HOUSING INSECURITY IN DC

Tom Fredericksen (TCP) introduced the report providing framing around the impetus for the study. Claudia Solari, Lynden Bond and Alavi Rashid from the Urban Institute presented the report on <u>Housing Insecurity in</u> the District of Columbia.

Comments, concerns, and questions from the discussion are captured on slides 50-51. Topic areas are summarized here for easy reference:

- Question and feedback on the definition of housing insecurity, including, rent burden and couch surfing.
- Reference to the DCFPI report issued in 2022 on <u>DC's Tools to create and preserve affordable housing</u>.
- Importance of affordable housing preservation in addition to development.
- Discussion on next steps with feedback that the study confirmed gaps that were already known and the root causes need to be addressed.
