## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

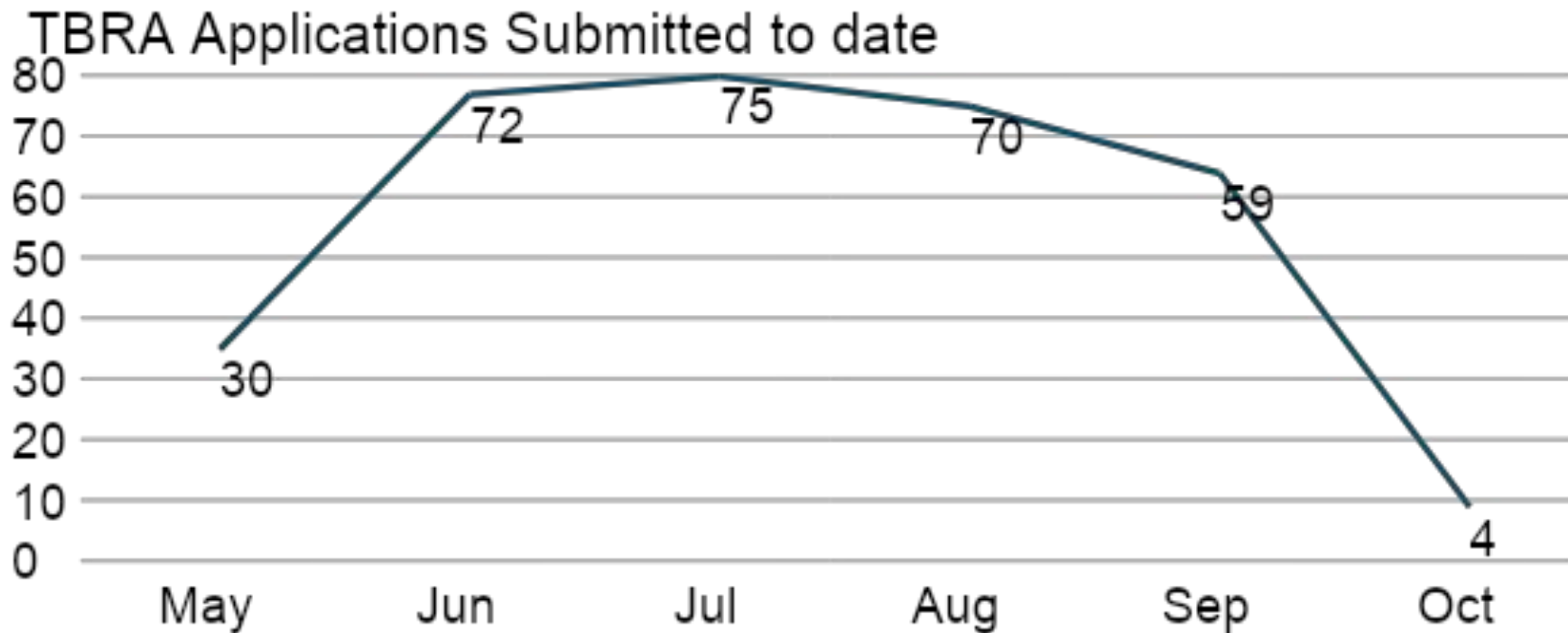

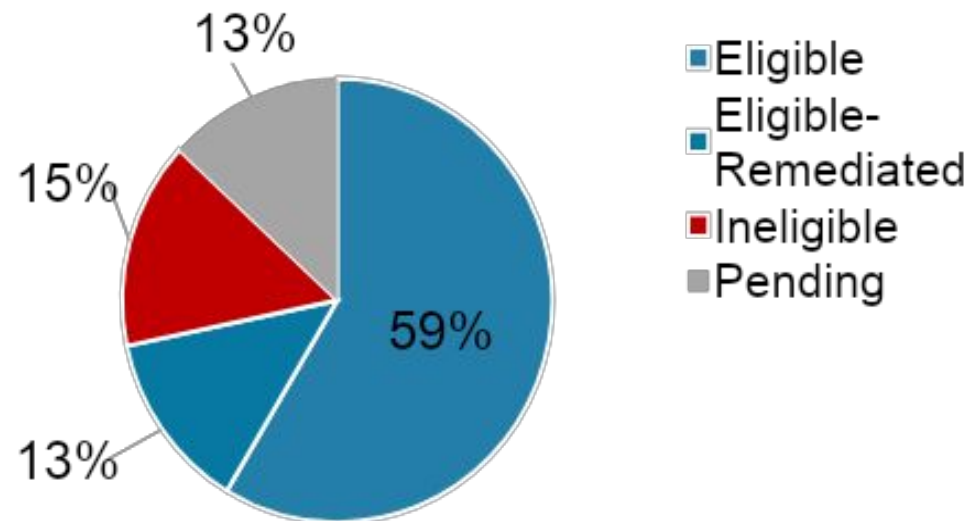


# TBRA Lead Hazard Inspections

# Eviction Prevention

- Interagency collaboration to establish and implement a coordinated plan to mitigate housing instability and eviction and to prevent a surge in homelessness
- The Mayor extended the public health emergency until 12/31/20; the eviction moratorium remains in place through February (for 60 days post PHE)

# Emergency Rental Assistance Program

- In FY20, ERAP approved 1,565 applications and expended all available funding; we did not see an increase in applications despite the pandemic
- In FY21, the ERAP budget is increased to \$14M

# ERAP Emergency Legislation

- Amends eligibility criteria, including setting income limit to 40% AMI
- Increases maximum allowable payment
- Grants DHS authority to waive restriction on number of months funds may cover rent arrearages during public health emergency
- DHS is working on rulemaking to clarify implementation details
