 - Introductions
- II. Discussion Items (See attached slides)
 - Feedback on Consolidated RFP: invited feedback on project criteria, priority classifications, timeline, and threshold and financial criteria
 - Recommendation to cap MFI limits at 20% or 15% to better serve unhoused people, as well as expand housing investments in Rock Creek West
 - Observation that 24-hour monitoring requirement for limited site-based PSH may incentivize developers to keep # of PSH units below the threshold (12-17 units);
 - Confusion around definition of 24-hour monitoring (e.g., does a 24-hour emergency maintenance line meet that requirement?)
 - Given current real estate environment and unprecedent # of vouchers, no path forward for ready-to-go site that does not need construction or rehab but would benefit from Project Based Vouchers to serve people coming out of homelessness
 - Ask for additional information on resources for those who will not be able to leverage Dec. 3 RFP application or qualify for priority classification.
 - Creating deeply affordable housing for singles not matched to PSH; District has ~ \$17M of HOME-ARP funds to spend on program (does not need to be spent within the year); targeting individuals at/below 50% AMI

 - Submit comments via the Consolidated RFP Q/A process (link available in the PPT).
 - Suggestions and comments from group included:
 - Creating workforce housing by targeting employed individuals in our system
 - Creating a home share / funded roommate matching program
 - Targeting elderly with fixed incomes, based on prior experience with TAH opportunities
 - Caution that the deeply affordable housing model may not be feasible with minimal, or no case management supports based on experience with existing SROs
