 Welcome – Kelly Sweeney McShane welcomed the committee and provided an overview of the agenda. She also shared that Tania Mortensen has taken a different role at DHS and so Rachel Pierre will be the new government Co-Chair for the committee. Kelly thanked Tania for her leadership.

• Updates/Announcements:

- FY22 Budget Tania Mortensen from the Department of Human Services did a high level review of the additional resources coming, especially for single adults, in FY 2022.
- 801 East Solicitation Tania also shared that a Solicitation has been released for services at the 801 East men's facility. The grant is to cover a provider responsible for delivering programming. Operations are currently covered by the Community Partnership and Catholic Charities. Proposals are due 9/27 by 5 p.m. The site expected to open doors for residents at the beginning of January 2022.

• Discussion Items

- Capacity Building Theresa Silla then shared that ICH and DHS are doing focus groups with providers to discuss the topic of capacity building amongst providers. Theresa asked the committee to provide feedback on whether and how to best do focus groups. The committee generally liked the ideas of focus groups and had recommendations to share with ICH and DHS as they are thinking about increasing capacity quickly.
- FY22 Priorities Kimberly Waller then reviewed the proposed priorities for both the Strategic Planning Committee and the various work groups.

• Partner Updates/Announcements

- O Kelly provided an overview of the DC Calling All Sectors Initiative, focusing on people who are pregnant and experiencing homelessness. She said that a survey is coming to providers shortly and asked them to fill it out to gather baseline data on the number of people who are pregnant and experiencing homelessness, and what special services are provided. There will also be focus groups with clients, as well as a presentation by Community of Hope on their programs at the Mayor's Maternal and Infant Health Summit.
- o Tania Mortensen shared that DHS is hiring and posted a link.
- o Tom Fredericksen stated that the Notice of Funding from HUD has come out, and there will be some funds for new programs. More information will be coming out.
- Nechama Masliansky shared that SOME will be working with students and nonprofits to research Covid hesitancy and encouraged any who were interested to let her know.
