- ❖ Proposed Topics
 - Addressing Racial Equity Issues within the CoC
 - Building Provider Capacity
 - Addressing System Inflow
 - Addressing Complex Health Needs
 - Addressing Trauma and Violence/Coordination with DV system
 - Employment/Income
- ❖ Criteria for helping determine where we need work groups to support plan development:
 - Topic is critical to successful system reform efforts
 - Little to no work underway yet

Project Team Lead Responsibilities

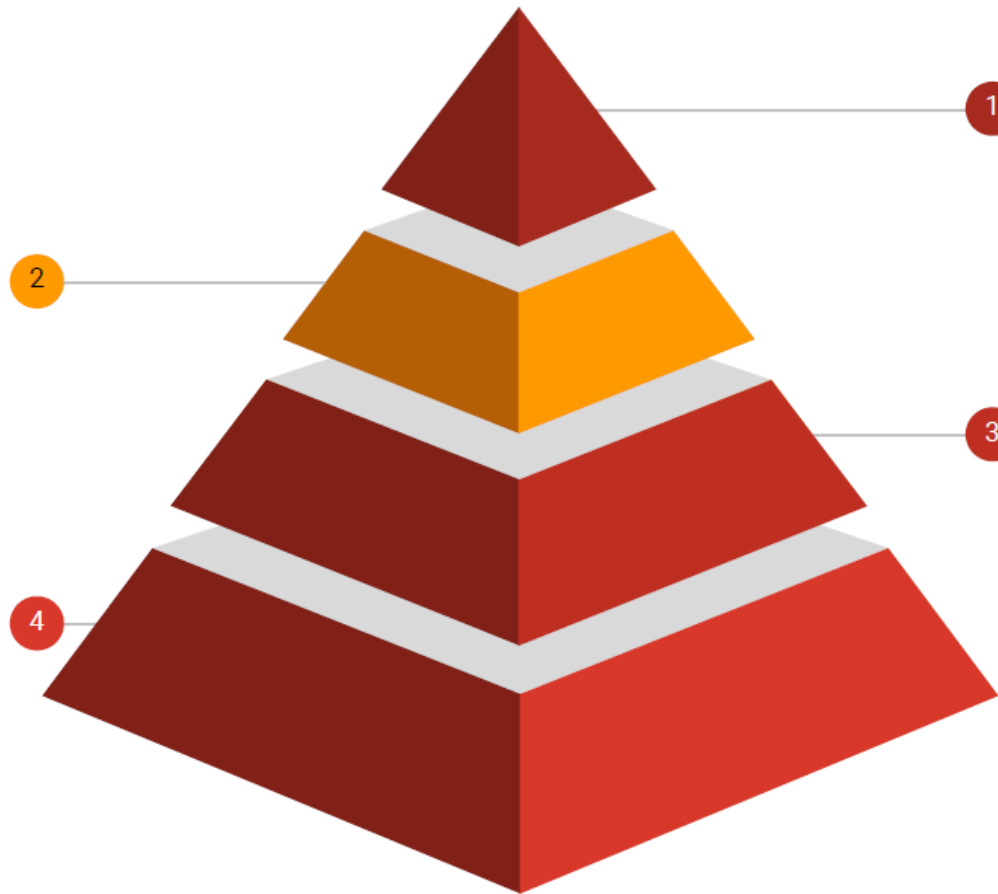


Strategic Plan

End chronic homelessness among individuals and families, in part by developing a more effective crisis response system (i.e. year-round access, closing DC general, opening STFH. & creating a daytime service center for single adults).

Policies & Procedures

Grants, contracts, human care agreements, policies, and program manuals.



Mission Statement

End long term homelessness in DC by 2020 by making it rare, brief, and non-recurring.

Implementation Plans

- DC General Closure plan
- DC General Family Shelter Replacement Plan
- Daytime Services Plan

Questions for Each Team to Address



- ❖ What is the specific problem or problems that need to be addressed?
 - What does our data tell us about this issue?
 - Does the issue impact people experiencing homelessness only? Or does it impact other people/populations?
- ❖ What strategies should be considered? For each strategy:
 - ✓ Is it within the sole influence of the homeless services system? If not, are certain aspects within the control of the homeless services system?
 - ✓ Is the strategy necessary to achieving the vision (homelessness is rare, brief, & nonrecurring)?
 - ✓ What resources are needed?
 - ✓ Are statutory or regulatory changes needed?
 - ✓ Which partners need to be involved?
 - ✓ What implementation challenges/barriers are anticipated?
 - ✓ How would we define/measure success?
- ❖ Out of the list of strategies, which should be prioritized for immediate implementation?
