Meeting Notes

I. WELCOME AND AGENDA REVIEW

Eileen Rosa (Special Advisor, ICH) welcomed members to the meeting with an icebreaker on the Homeless Youth Census underway. Elisabeth Youth (Deputy Chief of Policy and Programs, TCP) shared timely updates and reminders for the HYC. Details from the discussion are included in slide 3 - 6 of the PPT.

Co-chair Sheila Clark (Deputy Administrator for Youth Services, DHS) introduced herself and welcomed the group.

A. DEEP DIVE ON YOUTH KPI DATA

Theresa Silla (Executive Director, ICH) facilitated this discussion with framing from previous meetings. Tom Fredericksen (Chief of Policy and Programs, TCP) covered the KPI methodology. Please refer to slides 12 - 16 for details.

Comments, feedback, and questions are recorded on slides 17 - 23. Highlights are outlined below for easy reference:

- Clarifying questions on difference between permanent destinations and positive exits.
- Question on number of young adults served in the adult system.
- Discussion on the number of permanent housing resources for young adults.
- Concern about how the data is calculated and presented.
- Recommendation to focus on data collection, quality, and resource dashboards in FY24.
- Feedback that outreach uses ERAP and Project Reconnect to connect young adults, but those exits are likely not reflected in the KPI data.
- Concern that the KPI data creates a false narrative.
- Discussion on next steps to address discrepancies and data quality moving forward.
