


ICH Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) Production Committee

- History of Committee**
 - ICH created a Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) Production Committee as a result of the planning process for the April 2010 Strategic Action Plan to End Homelessness.
- Committee Deliverables:**
 - An annual production recommendation
 - A consolidated application process for PSH financing
 - Monitoring of PSH production accomplishments
- Committee Meetings**
 - Typically a mix of District agency staff, service providers, developers and advocates
 - Committee meets the first Tuesday of every even month- meetings are open to all
 - Working group meetings are scheduled as needed, and are also open meetings



Consolidated Request for Proposals (RFP)

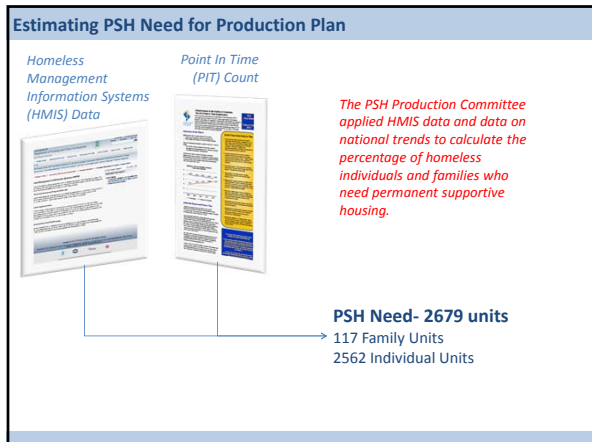


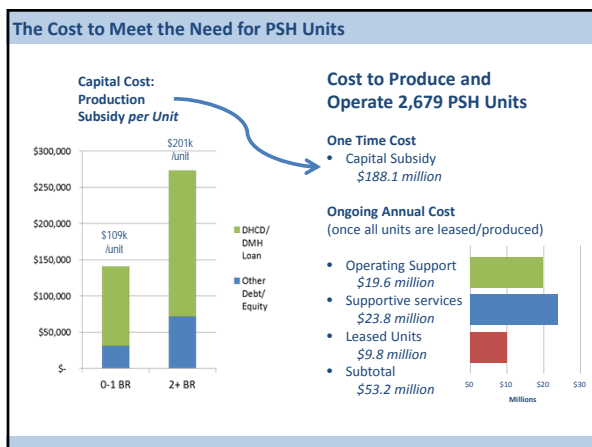
Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

- Executed: 2/27/13
- Parties: DHCD, DCHA, DMH, DHS, DCHFA

The current Consolidated RFP is a single application for funding for capital, operating, and supportive services for permanent supportive housing units.

Released: April 2, 2013
Deadline: May 31, 2013





- ### Committee Recommendations
- Ensure coordinated intake and referrals to ensure that the PSH units developed serve the most vulnerable homeless individuals and families.
 - Conduct cost benefit research on the impact of permanent supportive housing to identify savings, and understand where cost reductions are occurring within the system
 - Increase opportunities for philanthropic support and strategic collaboration (e.g. with Business Improvement Districts)
 - The PSH Production Committee should work in conjunction with the ICH Strategic Planning Committee to ensure that the ICH Annual Strategic Plan reflects PSH Production Committee recommendations.
